Tilghman Elementary School Water System

Statement of All Non-Lead Service Lines

Talbot County Public Schools (“TCPS”) has completed the service line inventory at Tilghman Elementary School, as required by U.S. EPA’s Lead and Copper Rule Revisions.

Through a review of records regarding installation date of service lines, we have determined that all service lines in our water distribution system are of non-lead material. Under Maryland law (COMAR 09.20.11.10A), effective May 17, 1972, lead was not included as one of the acceptable materials to be used for water service pipes.

Tilghman Elementary School has met the criteria outlined above by conducting a required records review and has determined that there are no Lead or Galvanized Requiring Replacement (GRR) service lines in our distribution system.

As required, TCPS has reviewed the following records associated with our water system at Tilghman Elementary School:

- TCPS has reviewed the well completion reports housed at the Talbot County Environmental Health Office
- TCPS design records from the most recent school renovation
- Visual inspections of the well and service line materials
