

Tilghman Watermen's Museum Scholarship

The Tilghman Watermen's Museum has created a scholarship for the Tilghman area watermen's community. The Scholarship will be awarded to a deserving undergraduate student furthering their education at an accredited technical school, two year or four year college.

Eligibility

To be eligible the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Graduate from Tilghman Elementary School or live in the Tilghman School area during their high school years.
- Have been accepted as a full time student in a higher educational program.
- Have a minimum of 2.75 Grade Point Average.
- Is a graduating senior from high school.

Number of Scholarships

There is the possibility of 3 scholarships.

Criteria for Award

The recipient will be selected by the TWM Scholarship Committee and approved by the TWM Board.

Value of Award

The recipient that is honored with this scholarship will receive \$1,000.00 awarded to the student in June.

Application

A student who wishes to be considered can fill out the application and mail with the supporting documents to the attention of the TWM Scholarship Committee PO Box 344, Tilghman, Maryland 21671 and must be postmarked no later than April 1 of the year for which the student is asking to be considered.

All applicants must use the official Tilghman Watermen's Museum Scholarship Form.

The following supporting documents must be submitted with the application form:

- Copy of the student's current high school transcript
- Copy of acceptance letter from an accredited institution of higher learning.
- One page letter of recommendation from a non-family member addressing the student's character.
- An essay by the applicant. The essay should address why you want to attend a college or training school and what
 are the experiences that led you to this decision.
