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Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- a. The student must be a female student of color of senior status, planning to enter post-secondary studies the semester following graduation.
- b. The student must have a high school grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale in academic subjects in grades 9 through the first semester of 12th grade.
- c. The student must have a composite SAT score of 1000 or better or 19 on the ACT.
- d. Consideration will be given to finalists, semifinalists and recipients of letters of commendation for the National Merit Program and or the National Achievement Scholarship Program for Outstanding Student.
- e. Consideration will be given for publications, recognized achievement, and outstanding service in community or school affairs.
- f. The student must submit two (2) letters of recommendation from persons other than relatives.
- g. The student must reside in Caroline, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne, Talbot, Wicomico or Worcester County.

Application Procedure

- a. The student must secure an application from the Guidance Counselor or from any member of the sorority. This application should be typed or computer generated.
- b. The completed application and letters of recommendation must be postmarked and mailed or emailed to the scholarship chairperson by February 28, 2025.
- c. The chairperson of the scholarship committee must receive the following information:
 - Completed application
 - 2 letters of recommendation
 - Official school transcript
 - Test scores
