The Jump award is given to a graduating female and male senior.

GUIDELINES FOR THE SELECTION:

The candidates must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a graduating senior attending High School.
2. Exemplify good citizenship and leadership qualities as a role model to their peers.
3. Have a good scholastic record and kept honor roll status.
4. Accepted to a two-year college, four-year college or trade school.

Selection Committee and guidelines:

1. The committee will consist of the following faculty from St. Michaels High School with each receiving input from key associates:
 - a. Senior class guidance counselor
 - b. Honor Society advisor
2. The committee shall meet and review the candidates to see who best fits the award criteria.
3. The committee will select two female and two male candidates and provide their names and reasons for recommending them to the Easton Lion club education committee no later than April 15.

The education committee will review the candidates and make the final choice. The senior class guidance counselor will be notified of the winners of the awards.

The award for each winner will consist of the following:

1. Monetary award of \$1500.00. This award can go to the college or winner.
2. A framed certificate
3. Each candidate will attend an Easton Lions club meeting to be recognized for this award.

The members of the Easton Lions Scholarship committee will present the awards at the St. Michaels High School Awards night.
